Obedience: Utility B/A, Open ODX B/A, Open CDX B/A, Novice B/A (group exercise will follow completion of Novice A individual exercises), Beginner Novice B/A

Rally: Masters C/B/A, Excellent C/B/A, Advanced C/B/A, Novice C/B/A

SITE INFORMATION:

The trials will be held at Thorson's Arena at Watsonville Ct, San Martin, CA. This is a covered arena with dirt footing. The grounds will be open each trial day from approximately 7:30 am to 6:00 pm.

Directions to Thorson's arena: from San Jose, take 101 south to Morgan Hill. Exit at Tennant Ave. At the end of the offramp bear right. (From Gilroy/Salinas, take 101 north to Morgan Hill. Exit at Tennant Ave. At the end of the offramp turn left and cross over the freeway.) Turn left at the traffic light at Butterfield Blvd. Butterfield Blvd becomes Watsonville Rd at Monterey Rd. In 2 ¼ miles turn left onto Watsonville Ct and into the Thorson's Arena parking lot.

SCHEDULE (each day):

Morning trial: Trial will start at 8:00. Day-of entries for both am and pm trials (if available) will be accepted 7:00-8:00.

Afternoon trial: Trial will start 30 minutes after the completion of the morning trial, but not earlier than 12:00. Day-of entries for pm trial (if available) will be accepted for up to one hour before the start of the afternoon trial, beginning no earlier than the competition of the morning trial.

AWARDS:

Obedience: 1st-4th ribbons for all classes; Qualifying ribbons for scores of 170 or higher; Rosettes for High in Trial in the regular classes, Highest Combined Score in Open B and Utility and Highest Scoring Junior Handler in the regular classes, High Scoring Aussie.

Rally: 1st-4th ribbons for all classes; Qualifying ribbons for scores of 170 or higher; X Qualifying ribbons for scores of 195 or higher; Rosettes for High in Trial from the A/B classes, High Combined from Excellent B and Masters B, and High in Trial Junior from the A/B classes, High Scoring Aussie.

ENTRY INFORMATION:

All dogs must have an ASCA registration number, a LEP number or a QTracker number to participate in these trials. More information about and an application for a QTracker number is available at <https://www.asca.org/wp-content/uploads/2016/04/trackapp.pdf>.

No entry will be accepted from a dog or handler disqualified from ASCA Obedience, Rally or all ASCA programs; nor a person not in good standing with ASCA.

Pre entries must be postmarked by Wednesday November 11, 2020 and received by 6:00 pm Wednesday November 18, 2020.

No pre entries nor day-of-trial entries will be accepted after the entry limit is reached. Please contact the trial secretary to verify day-of-trial availability.

Pre entry fees: \$15 per class; \$10 for the second class that a dog is entered in at any one trial. (Note: there are four trials over the weekend. This discounted price is only available for dogs entered in two classes in the same trial.)

Day-of-Trial entry fees (for entries NOT postmarked/received by the pre entry deadlines): \$20 per class. There is no discount for additional classes.

Entry forms: Both Obedience and Rally entry forms were updated in June, 2020. Only these entry forms will be accepted.

Volunteers are always welcome at ASCA trials. Without such help, we cannot conduct trials. If you're available to help during the trial—even for a short time—or can bring someone who can, please send an eMail to Lora (lora@rosscox.com) that describes your/their availability.

Please clean up after your dog. Please keep your dog on leash when not competing.

COVID-19 CONSIDERATIONS:

Do not come if you feel sick. Do not come if you have travelled out of the state and not sheltered in place for at least 14 days. Do not come if you have been to any large gatherings within 14 days of the trials.

Participants are required to follow state, local and facility guidelines that apply to COVID-19 safety.

Masks are required everywhere on the grounds—except in your car or at your setup. The judge may allow exhibitors to un-mask while they are in the ring: in that case, you must re-mask before exiting the ring. You must bring your own mask.

Everyone is encouraged to maintain 6' social distancing. Avoid shaking hands or hugging. Avoid touching dogs that are not your responsibility.

Additional COVID-19 safety instructions may be eMailed to exhibitors shortly before the trial.
