ASCA welcomes all breeds and mixed breeds. An ASCA Registration #, LEP #, or QT number will be required to track any titles. The application for the tracking number can be found here:

ASCA Dock Jumping Titles can be achieved in two ways.

1. ASCA Affiliate Clubs or
2. Approved Dock Jumping Organizations

Approved Dock Jumping Organizations will host their own sanctioned shows, have their own insurance and rules. These organizations will then send ASCA the results for the Business Office to record. ASCA will record the jump length per the divisions stated in Section 3.2 and Section 3.3.

****Ultimate Air Dog (UAD) is an Approved Dock Jumping Organization. To have your UAD jumps count for ASCA titles, just be sure to give your ASCA number when entering, and ask that results be sent to ASCA.**

Location: Stunt Dog Academy, 554 W. Matthews Rd., French Camp, CA 95231
Pool & dock are required competition dimensions.

Judge: Didi McElroy, Lathrop, CA

Briefing at 8:00 AM. Open dock 8:30 until 1st jump at 9:00am. Launches 1 & 2 will run concurrently, with a break for open dock & scoring to take place. Launches 3 & 4 will follow at 11:00, followed by a 1 hour lunch at the judges discretion. 5th & 6th launches will follow the lunch break. Launches will be judged according to Rule 3.1A. Open Dock will be available between launches, time permitting. Best of 2 jumps determines placement. \$25 a class or PRE-ENTRY PACKAGE: \$275 for all 12 launches. Pre-entries open May 4, 2024 & must be postmarked by June 2, 2024.

Day of entry limited to space available: \$30/launch. You can also apply for a QT number with your day of entries (see link above). Day of entries will remain open all day.

Awards: 1st place teams will receive a neck medal. Flat ribbons will be awarded for 2nd-4th place in each division.

No entry shall be accepted from a dog or handler disqualified from the ASCA Dock Jumping Program; a dog or handler disqualified from all ASCA programs; or a person not in good standing with ASCA. Bitches in season may not compete at this event.

Dock Jumping trials sanctioned only by the Australian Shepherd Club of America (ASCA) are governed by ASCA's "Dock Jumping Rules and Regulations"; by any rules and regulations set forth in the Premium for each trial (which shall not conflict with the "Dock Jumping Rules and Regulations"); and by the Bylaws of the Australian Shepherd Club of America. Directions to the event site: From I-5 North, take Exit 467B toward Matthews Rd. Turn left onto W. Matthews Rd. for .7 miles. Turn left & the destination is on the right at the corner of W. Matthews & Bright Rd. The entrance is on Bright Rd. Park on the dirt. ****There will be limited space available for trailers, please ask the trial chair before planning on bringing one.**** Canopies for shade or x-pens may be set up on the grass around the pool.

** Note to competitors: there are no practice jumps in the launch. If you need to practice or get your dog wet, please do so during open dock before launches commence.

****Open Dock** - Open Dock is offered between launches, time permitting. It is available free of charge to all competitors all day. Each open dock dog gets two jumps and then may get back in line. It is also available for \$15 per dog per day for non-competitors. Non-competitors must first pay the fee of \$15 to the trial chair. Anyone going on the dock will be required to sign a liability waiver. This is designed for teams who would like to become familiar with the pool and dock while introducing their dogs to the sport. They must get at the end of the line to accommodate those who wish to practice who are in the competition.
