Rules:

- All dogs that Q in one Regular class are entered automatically.
- A dog must compete in at least 2 PASA trials.
- All Qs in all classes are counted.
- 10 point Qs earn 1 point. 5 point

Qs earn 1/2 point.

- A dog's category for the series is determined by its 1st Regular Q.
- At the end of the series the dog with the most points in the categories Standard Elite, Open, and Novice, Veteran, and Jr. Handler levels and overall ACE will win a Silver Buckle award and a rosette. Tie breakers are average YPS time in Regular over the series, average YPS time in Regular in their last trial, highest Gamblers point average in their last trial.
- A dog run by a junior may have that dog's runs count toward Jr. Handler instead of the dog's entered category if the dog's category has not been determined.
- A dog can win a Silver Buckle award only once in the same category except Jr. Handler. Dogs competing in a category they have already won are placed in a Winners category. The top Winners Dog receives a large rosette.
- PASA reserves the right to add trials to this series within 30 days of any trial date. Cancelled trials are removed from the series.
- Awards will be made at the November 16/17, 2024 Agility Trial.
