CONFIRMATIONS including information regarding classes you have entered will be emailed to all entrants who have provided a valid email. **PLEASE READ YOUR CONFIRMATIONS!!** General confirmations will be mailed to all entered about a week before the trial and will include general information as well as check-in time, walk-through/start times and tentative class running orders.

CLASS CHANGES: Moveups must be submitted in writing (email ok) and must be received by the Trial Secretary before **5:00 PM Tuesday, September 14, 2010.**

Moveups will be allowed at the trial from Saturday to Sunday – The moveup form will be posted at the score table. All moveup requests must be on the form within 30 minutes after the last class has finished on Saturday. **NO Exceptions!**

AWARDS: PASA offers ribbons for First through Fourth place in each class for each jump height division. 20+” and 24” dogs will be scored together. Rosettes in the ASCA color of green will be offered to every dog obtaining a qualifying score. Dogs that complete an ATCH receive a large rosette and a decorated pole for signing.

HIGH IN TRIAL AWARDS will be awarded to the highest scoring dog(s) in the following categories (5 awards in all): Rosettes to HIT in the Novice, Open and Elite levels (Standard division), Junior and Veteran Divisions. A dog's category will be based upon the level/division in which the dog competes in its last Regular class. All Qs are counted. Qs receive 5 pts. for novice, 6 pts. for open and 7 pts for elite. Faulted Qs received ½ the value. High point dog in each category is the winner. YPS in regular and jumpers Qed classes is the tie breaker

Silver Buckle Series - All dogs with a qualifying run will be entered in the 2010 Silver Buckle Series. Awards will be presented at the September 18/19, 2010 Trial to the top Elite, Open, Novice, Veteran & Jr. Handler dog. For details see the events page at www.pasadoogs.com.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

This trial will be held under the current rules and regulations of ASCA. Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of ASCA rules and regulations, and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of this trial. A copy of ASCA's Agility Rulebook may be downloaded free from the ASCA web site: www.asca.org.

All dogs must be on a leash when not competing in the ring. No set ups within 15 feet of any ring.

Safety shall always be the foremost consideration in actions and conduct by handlers at all times. In all cases, regardless of the situation, the judge's decisions are final.

No entry shall be accepted from a dog or handler disqualified from the ASCA agility or all ASCA programs; or a member/person not in good standing with ASCA. The organizing committee may refuse any entry on the basis expressly provided through ASCA rules and regulations or guidelines established by the ASCA Board of Directors.

Equipment list: Jumps, tunnels, weave poles, tire, teeter, slatted dog walk and A-frame. Electronic timing will be used.

Note: Junior Handlers are under 18 years. Novice A is for dogs, owners and handlers who have never earned an agility title in **any** venue.

Refunds: No refunds are given for entries withdrawn after the closing date. No refund is given if a dog or handler is dismissed from competition, regardless of the reason. No refund is given if the trial cannot open or be completed due to riots, civil disturbances, fire, acts of god, public emergency, acts of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the Show Committee's control. The show will not be cancelled in the event of rain. Refunds of 50% of the entry fees paid will be issued for injured dogs or bitches in season if submitted to the trial secretary in writing by 8 a.m. on Saturday before the trial. A letter from your vet indicating the dog's condition may be requested in order to process the refund.

Checks not honored by the bank do not constitute a valid entry fee. There will be a \$20.00 service charge for returned checks. Payment of entry fees and service charges shall be made in cash or money order within 30 days of postmark of notice of returned check. ASCA will be notified if any fees are not received within 30 days of notice. All awards must be returned within 10 days of notification. Any unpaid fees or shortfalls must be paid prior to the start of the event or entry is cancelled without recourse by owner/handler.

Please clean up after yourself and your dog. Please also keep hotel rooms and grounds clean so that hotels will continue to allow dogs to stay.

The Show Committee will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any exhibitor whether the result was by accident or any other cause.

It is distinctly understood that every dog at this event is in the care and custody and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises. Please take responsibility for your dogs and children. Any exhibitor whose dogs or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Show Committee be asked to leave the show site. There will be no refunds for entries if a dog or handler is dismissed from competition for any reason.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS – CONTINUED

PERMANENT MEASUREMENT CARDS – Dogs with a standard jump height of 20" or greater do not need to be measured. All other heights must be measured or present a NADAC or AKC permanent height card.

Beginning 1/1/2003 for non-ASCA registered dogs – In order to have ASCA qualifying legs tracked and to receive ASCA titling certificates, each non-ASCA registered dog will be required to have an ASCA Tracking Number. **This is a one-time fee of \$10/dog.**

At the time of applying for the tracking number, **the individual owner must also be an ASCA member** (minimum membership type of 'Service' is required). ASCA membership does not need to be maintained in subsequent years. It will be the responsibility of the owner to identify to ASCA the shows and legs earned when applying for a Tracking Number for those ASCA qualifying legs earned from 1/1/2003 until submission of application.

Important Park Rules So We Don't Get Kicked Out! NO ALCOHOL!

This park is run by a youth recreation league and there must be NO ALCOHOL, and in particular, there MUST BE NO SIGN OF ALCOHOL. Not in your hands (use cups!), not in the trash (take it home with you!), not in the recycling and not in the litter around our RV's. The park ranger will be patrolling throughout the weekend and especially during happy hour.

AGREEMENT

The person who signs this agreement represents that he/she is authorized to enter into this agreement on behalf of both exhibitor and the owner of entered dog. In consideration of acceptance of this entry the signor also agrees that:

- 1.1 As used here: ASCA means Australian Shepherd Club of America, its affiliate clubs, and each of their members, officers, directors, employees, show chairs, show committees and agents.
- 1.2 Exhibitor/owner agrees to abide by the rules and regulations of ASCA, and any other rules and regulations appearing in the premium for this event.
- 1.3 Exhibitor/owner certifies that the entered dog is not a hazard to persons, dogs, or property and that the entered dog's rabies vaccination is current in accordance with the requirement of the state in which the dog resides
- 1.4 Exhibitor/owner acknowledges all hazards presented by the event and the event premises, including, but not limited to, the condition of the grounds, lighting, security measures or lack thereof, electrical appliances, fittings, show rings, parking areas and the presence of unfamiliar animals, and people; exhibitor/owner assumes the risk of any harm arising for these.
- 1.5 Exhibitor/owner releases ASCA, the ASCA affiliate, Peninsula Australian Shepherd Association, North county Youth Recreation Association and the County of Monterey and will defend them and hold them harmless from all present and future loss, injury, damage, claims, demands and liabilities involving the entered dog, the event or event premises. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing hold harmless provisions, exhibitor/owner hereby specifically assumes responsibility for and agrees to indemnify and save aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expenses (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damages because of bodily injuries, including death, at any time in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, howsoever such injury, or death may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may have been alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents or any other persons.

2010 PASA FALL MVA COMPETITION

PASA is proud to offer a Most Versatile Aussie Award to recognize the dog which best combines the attributes of trainability, desire and ability to work livestock, and faithfully represents the breed standard. In order to qualify for this award, the dog must receive a qualifying score in a regular stock run, a qualifying score in a regular agility class or a qualifying score in a regular obedience class (this being the performance score). The dog also must enter in the breed standard evaluation by Senior Breeder Judge Ken Silveira at the Stockdog Trial. We will offer Agility and Obedience at the Western Roundup in Prunedale, September 18/19. The Stockdog Trial will be at Fiona's Farm in Brentwood, October 2/3. The dog with the highest points overall will win the Award. All dogs must have an ASCA registration number. No LEP registrations will be allowed. Bitches in heat can compete. Dogs may be intact or altered. The points will be awarded as follows:

Conformation Evaluation: 90 points possible. We will use the national evaluation as a guideline.

Stockdog score: The highest qualifying score from the Started, Open or Advanced classes will be used to compute MVA points. Additional qualifying scores will earn 5 points. Advanced scores will be the score + 6% of the score. Open scores will remain the same as will Started scores.

Obedience score: The highest qualifying score from a regular class will be used to compute MVA points. A qualifying Utility run will have 3% of score added. Open and Novice scores will remain the same.

Agility score: Only Regular Agility, from the standard, veterans or junior division will qualify. Points for MVA will be awarded as follows: 195 for qualifying clean Elite run, 190 for a qualifying faulted Elite run, 185 for a qualifying clean Open run, 180 for a qualifying faulted Open run, 175 for a clean Novice run and 170 for a qualifying faulted Novice run.

The highest score from one of the performance events will be used to compute the MVA points. All other qualifying runs in either of the performance events will be worth an additional 5 points.

Therefore, each dog's total points will consist of three parts: the conformation evaluation, a stock score and a performance score.

The cost of entering this competition is \$20.00, to be included in your agility or obedience entries.
