Things need to move along faster. It takes the same time to run 140 runs as it does for some clubs to run 350 runs. Down time between class kills us on time.... and yelling for help over and over does no one any good, especially when help is already on task and in the ring

I expected an exercise area, not weeds with horse dung.

Appreciate that this was a new site for PASA so a takeaway lesson should be for new sites is to find out if ground can be drilled into to hold the equipment. It was fortunate that sandbags were obtained but a shame in the lost time waiting.

Moved along faster

A fenced designated dog exercise area would be nice.

Wish the 'other things' for this site would allow us to return. I am so grateful for all the PASA members that rallied together to make it work. 😊

It was unfortunate that the course builders were handicapped by the arena surface. We should have had a deeper discussion about our requirements. I hope we won't run into these issues in the future. Maybe some communication with other clubs and their trial locations?

I think 99% of your members are nice and try to be supportive, but I had a bad experience with one of them. My dog and I did not have good runs when we were there this past weekend. Much worse than the other two trials we have attended. And I left feeling very bad because we had performed poorly and because one of your members told me that because my dog and I had a hard time our trainer probably didn't even want us to be in the ring. I did not appreciate this at all and therefore I may not return to the PASA trials. It would have been okay if they had given me some encouragement but to tell me that our trainer probably didn't even want us in the ring hit hard. This is the first dog I have ever raised and yes, he/she is not perfect and may not be as well trained as most of the other members dogs. But we are new to agility and are out there trying. Comments like that are not good for people new to agility nor are they good for the organization and I know you are trying to increase the membership. But maybe that's just how Agility competitions are. I will seek Agility competitions with other organizations for the time being. I am sorry that I feel this way but think you all should know even if it was just a misunderstanding in communication.
